Measuring intangible IS Assets (Data, Rules and Processes) Assessing Enterprise Architecture

Objective

This one-day workshop, dedicated to your company, highlights the IS Rating Tool concepts which are established by the Sustainable IT Architecture. The objective is to measure the intrinsic value of IS Assets based on shared data (MDM), business rules (BRMS) and processes (BPM) through three domains of assessment: mastering knowledge (formalization, modeling, sharing, funding), bringing governance functions (permissions management, versions management, auditability, traceability, etc.) and mastering key IT implementation mechanisms (repositories integration, it means MDM+BRMS+BPM at the scale of the whole IS).

This workshop shows why and how usual Enterprise Architecture frameworks, such as TOGAF and Zachman, must be completed with an approach to support a progressive IS transformation. This approach relies on the linking value of the three business repositories MDM, BRMS and BPM. They establish the targeted IS foundation, bringing a better auditability, transparency and involvement of business users to govern their IS Assets.

Introduction

- The reasons encouraging IS/IT changes to face databases concerns (lack of data quality, scattering of repository) and to face the Internet of Objects. The path to regain a high level of IS auditability and traceability for all stakeholders.

Terms definition

- Terms used in the approach of measuring intangible IS assets: intangible assets, linking value, use value, business value, intrinsic value, performance level, rating.

Pitfalls of Enterprise Architecture

- Enterprise Architecture definition and presentation of its limits when there is a lack of concrete vision to transform IS/IT.

The targeted IS/IT foundation to support the transformation

- The natural path to transform IS/IT systems is based on the linking value of business repositories, namely MDM (Master Data Management), BRMS (Business Rules Management System) and BPM (Business Process Management). Describing of delivery lifecycle relying on a step by step IS/IT transformation.

Key concepts of the IS Rating Tool

- Describing of the three domains of measurement: mastering knowledge, bringing governance functions, enforcing IT integration. Matrix of the three intangible IS assets (Data, Rules, Processes) with the three domains of measurement, it means nine cells. Each cell is associated with a list of questions used to assess the system. The performance level is measured through a scale from low to optimize that defines five types of situation applied to each question. The crossing of about 100 questions with five situations brings about 500 measurement points to fully assess the intrinsic value of IS Assets.
